BEVERAGE CART ATTENDANT

POSITION: SEASONAL (MARCH – DECEMBER) / PAY RATE: \$8.25 PER HOUR

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Under the supervision of the Golf Course Professional, the Beverage Car Driver:
- Assumes responsibility for customer service.
- Performs food and beverage functions at the Peoria Park District golf courses.
- Serves food and beverages to guests.
- Understands purpose and proper use of the pro shop log book.
- Notifies Course Golf Professional of food or beverage supply needs.
- Collects payment from guests.
- Completes end of day balance sheets.
- Is responsible for checking I.D.'s to establish legal drinking age.
- Monitors guest alcohol consumption to ensure the safety of guests.
- Is available to work weekends and holidays.
- Is responsible for all areas covered in the operations manual for the golf shop.
- Follows all safety procedures that pertain to the duties performed. Supports all aspects of the Peoria Park District's safety program.
- Reports any vandalism, unusual condition, emergency situation, or incident to the Head Golf Professional.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.
- Must be 21 years of age.
- Assists staff including starters, marshals, pro shop staff and manager on duty.
- Complies with all food service sanitation and requirements mandated by the Health Department.

SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES WILL HAVE

- High school diploma. Experience in a like position may be used for all or part of the education requirements.
- Ability to follow written and oral instructions. Ability to represent the Peoria Park District and insure that the District's policies are followed in a firm, friendly and totally impartial manner. Ability to work harmoniously with Peoria Park District personnel and to deal effectively with the public.
- Ability to lift and move up to 30 pounds.
- Ability to stand for long periods of time.
- Ability to bend and stoop.
- Ability to drive and park golf cars to and from storage area.
- Ability to operate a cash register, computer and walkie talkie.
- Must be able to distinguish colors.
- Ability to follow verbal and written instructions.
- Ability to operate a gasoline powered golf car/refreshment vehicle.
- Must have a valid and current driver's license.

OTHER

TO RETAIN GOLF PRIVILEGES:

Employee must work at least 15 hours per week per manager schedule; 30 hours in one pay period.

EMPLOYEE PRIVILEGES:

- Green fees are waived for seasonal part-time employees. (No charge).
- Employees pay \$8.00 for the use of golf cars. Employees are responsible for ensuring their passengers pay all required fees and register with the starter before the round begins.
- Range privilege – \$1.00 for one (1) any-sized bucket of range balls per day (employee use only).
- Pro Shop Merchandise – Employees shall receive a pro shop merchandise discount of 20%. (This can be applied and used in conjunction to sales, specials, etc.).
- Loyalty Points – Employees can earn loyalty points, which can be redeemed for pro shop purchases.
- Employee's season golf pass will expire when they are done working or at the end of the season.
